Q: What is the nature of your business, and what makes yours different?
A: We specialize in and practice family law. Divorce, custody, support, property division, pension plans, business evaluations, anything that has anything to do with somebody getting a divorce or having an issue regarding children. They call it "Family Law" but it's a bunch of stuff and it's all generally related to work that happens when people split from each other.

Q: Are your customers mostly local or from distant locations?
A: I have a handful of clients from other areas. For the most part, my clients are local in the sense that they're local to L.A. and Ventura counties

Q: What's the biggest challenge your company faces today?
A: Probably the biggest challenge for my business is the same as every business which is just, we're subject to the vagaries of the economy. The problem with divorce work is that when the economy gets bad and money gets tight, it usually exacerbates marital problems. When the economy goes south, money gets tight, the fights start and it becomes harder for people to stay together.

Q: What's your favorite part of the work you do?
A: My favorite part of what I do is I'm able to help people get through an extremely difficult time in their life. With family law it's not so much winning and losing as it is managing and helping people through the process. My goal is to allow people who get a divorce and who have children to be able to dance at their children's wedding, to sit next to each other when their child graduates.

Q: Do you find it hard separating work and home life?
A: I would have to say it's a challenge. My wife and I are both divorce lawyers and we both know how things can end really bad. I joke sometimes that I think the fact that my wife and I are both divorce attorneys keeps us married.
